Minimum 2 night stay in Pods/Bell Tents and for camping on weekends. Min. 3 night stay on bank holidays, except for the late May bank/half term holiday which is a min. 5 night stay.

## Site Rules

- Please respect campsite staff, grounds and other visitors. Remember, everybody else is here on holiday too!
- No car engines, music or TVs to be operated between 11pm and 8am.
- Noise to be at a reasonable level at all times and kept to a minimum between the above times.
- Group bookings or anybody found to not be respecting their fellow campers may be subject to paying a refundable behaviour bond of £20 per adult. This will be refunded on your day of departure providing all site rules are adhered to.
- No campfires - You can still have a fire as long as it is contained in a raised fire pit (bbqs should be raised from the ground too!).
- Dogs are welcome on site, but must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. Dog mess must be picked up and disposed of immediately.
- Non-electric campers can pitch anywhere on our fields, but must respect a 3m gap between tents, including their guy lines.
- Electric campers must pitch on the gravel and park their vehicle on the grass.
- Camping ticket must be displayed at all times on your tent/awning so we can still see it if you are off-site in your vehicle.

## Local walks

We have put together guides for a few local walks, accessible from the campsite. Visit our shop, connect to the wi-fi, scan the QR codes below and you can download a free guide that can be used offline for when signal gets patchy!

### Arthur's Pike

Arthur's Pike overlooks Waterside, and is a short but varied walk, involving some steep bits, and a couple of streams to cross. The views of Ullswater are well worth the hike.

**Time: Approx. 2-3 hours**



### Barton

Barton Fell can be found along the same route as Arthur's Pike, but runs more parallel to our campsite instead of beyond it. This walk is great for the days when you want to just take it easy and enjoy your surroundings.

**Time: Approx. 1-2 hours**



### Gowbarrow

The ideal time to attempt Gowbarrow fell, is whilst visiting Aira Force waterfalls, as the fell is located just above them. Gowbarrow offers a different perspective of the lake, as it is on the opposite side to the campsite.

**Time: Approx. 2-4 hours**



### Hallin

Hallin fell is a staff favourite, easily accessible via the Ullswater steamer from Pooley Bridge, this walk is short and intense, but highly rewarding. If you don't want to climb up it, you can always walk around it and get similar views!

**Time: Approx. 1 hours**



### Helvellyn

Helvellyn is a bit tougher than any of the other walks, as it is the 3rd highest mountain in England! There are two possible routes you can take, but both require hard work and suitable clothing/equipment.

**Time: Approx. 3-6 hours**



## Waterside Gallery

Why not pop in and have a look around our gallery. You will find this located at the main entrance to the campsite and it is open daily. On display we have original paintings and prints from our very own Joan Lewis, along with local crafts and gifts. Commissions welcome.



## Lakeway Holiday Cottage

Lakeway is a beautiful 4 double-bedroom cottage situated a few miles from Waterside Campsite, you can find Lakeway in the quaint village of Tirril, around 5 minutes walk from the heart of the village and a Country Pub.
